Propuesta de actuación de la Terapia Ocupacional junto al niño con disturbios de imaginen corporal debido a violencia sexual

The effects of sexual violence on children are multifaceted including the physical, psychological, cognitive, and social effects. The results require the intervention of a multidiscipline team for the promotion of a complete rehabilitation of these children. The objective of this Project is to understand the sexually abused children universe, focusing on the body disturbances, above all the self-image problems caused by the trauma. In addition, it proposes an occupational therapy performance of a multidiscipline team to work with these patients. A literature review and a BIREME, SCIELO, and LILACS database virtual research was done in order to write this proposal. Based on this research, we concluded that a sexually abused child looses body integrity and learns to hate his/her own body because it brings back the memory of bad experiences. The occupational therapy with a multidiscipline team seeks to rehabilitate these children working their corporal aspects, by recovering the body integrity once lost. And that would be done through activities of getting to know oneself, acceptance and self expression so that the abused child can acknowledge that he/she is a whole being, with interconnected parts.
