## Guide to stimulation of pre-term babies: guidelines for parents to support informative for the promotion of child development

The literature points to the importance of the actions of support information for parents of children with high risk of biological and psychosocial disorders. The presence of risk can occur many moments the various factors associated or not. One such risk is the premature birth of a child according to the immaturity of their nervous system at birth. Given the systematic production of knowledge already disclosed and the purpose of this study is to report the process of selection of content that should constitute a guide for stimulation of premature addressed to parents who attend a service of monitoring the development of babies. The study was compiled from information obtained through a literature review of comments made in the service of attention the baby pre-term and effective through interviews with mothers and professionals. We obtained a guide containing general information on the development of the baby in the first four quarters of life. Furthermore, data on the importance of calculating corrected age for the monitoring of the milestones of development. It discusses the importance of verifying the applicability of this material produced in clinical settings, and outpatient hospital, and entry into new landscape of professional performance of the occupational therapist in Brazil: the family health units.
