1. **YOKOHAMA COSMOWORLD** 045-641-6591
An amusement park with a 112.5m 480-person capacity ferris wheel with the world's largest clock built-in. This is the most popular attraction, but there's also a fun roller coaster and water slide.

2. **Yokohama Red Brick Warehouse Ake Renga Park** 045-211-1515 (Bus) 045-222-2700 (Bus)
The traditional brick buildings of the Meiji and Taisho Eras make this a very popular spot. Buildings contain halls for concerts, exhibitions, lectures, and a multi-purpose space. Building 2 contains 50 terraces including live music bars, restaurants, and shops. The well-designed adjacent park with trees is a good place to relax.

This museum specializes in newspaper exhibitions, including a history of newspapers, production machines and processes, projected images and notices.

22. **NEWSPARK Japan Newspaper Museum** 045-661-2040
This museum specializes in newspaper exhibitions, including a history of newspapers, production machines and processes, projected images and notices.

23. **Silk Museum** 045-641-0841
One of the oldest museums in the world. This exhibition shows how silk is produced from silkworms and features silk clothing from various ages.

24. **Yokohama Archives of History** 045-201-2100
Exhibition of the history of Yokohama from the opening of the port to the end of the Edo era to the early Showa era.

25. **Yokohama Custom House Museum** 045-212-6053
Displays explain the history and role of the Yokohama Custom House, as well as related brand goods and methods used for smuggling contraband.
