



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


Introduction



Introduction

• The Eurostat Dissemination Database estimates that by the end of 2020, 23.7% of the Slovenian population will be 65 years or older.



Objectives

- The aim of our study was:
- ➤To better understand the current needs and the nature of assistance provided with ADL, IADL.
- ➤To know how older people assessed their independence in ADL, IADL.
- ≻To know who they wanted as their caregivers.



Methods

• Cross-sectional study.



- Community-dwelling adults over the age of 65.
- The questionnaire was presented to 635 people (358 agreed to participate voluntarily).
- The questionnaire consisted of:


>demographic characteristics;


➤ the level of independence in performing ADLs, IADLs;

> the assistance received with everyday acitivities.












Results







Conclusion

- Community-dwelling older Slovenians are more independent in their basic activities of daily living compared to instrumental activities of daily living (toilet, feeding).
- The majority of our participants did not use assistance for everyday activities.
- Those who had assistance used predominantly unpaid helpers, mostly their family members.
